St. Helens Little League Sponsorship Rights and Responsibilities

This agreement between St. Helens Little League, Inc., (hereafter, "SHLL" or "League") and the sponsoring organization (hereafter, "Sponsor") identified on the accompanying St. Helens Little League Sponsorship Agreement (on the reverse side of this form) is for the 2022 season.

Sponsorship of St. Helens Little League, a private, not-for-profit organization, is voluntary and must be, for the Sponsor, agreed to out of a sense of duty to help promote SHLL and its mission to benefit the local community. While sponsorship does afford some benefits, as explained in the Sponsorship Agreement, the higher purpose is to help SHLL impart the values of teamwork, sportsmanship, and fair play to the children of the community so that they may someday demonstrate these values in the exercise of good citizenship.

Sponsorship of SHLL and its programs does not afford the Sponsor any rights or responsibilities in the operations of St. Helens Little League or any team in the League, nor does the Sponsor have any rights or responsibilities in the selection of managers, coaches, or players for any team in the league. If the Sponsor team has a request for a child to be placed on a team, note that information on the front of the sponsorship form. Every reasonable attempt to grant the Sponsors request will be made. SHLL and the Sponsor remain independent of one another and neither shall have the authority or legal right to represent or bind the other in any manner to any extent whatsoever, except specified herein.

Sponsors shall have the right to use the following term in advertisements, posters, brochures, newsletter, etc. "Sponsor of St. Helens Little League."

Sponsorship of St. Helens Little League is for the benefit of the whole league. Sponsorships will be taken on a first come basis. Specific request for Sponsorship on the front of this form will be granted as long as those specific Sponsorships are open. Long time Sponsors will be given first right of refusal on any sponsorship.
